

**The Connecticut Kids Closet – Spring/Summer 2012  
Volunteer Consignor Agreement**

This agreement must be signed in order to consign at the Spring/Summer 2012 sale. By signing this agreement, you confirm that you have carefully read all of the guidelines and procedures and agree to the terms stated below:

1. You will receive 65% (sales tax not included) of the total amount your items sell for the first 3 hour shift worked.. You will receive 70% if you work two shifts. You will NOT be required to pay the \$10 registration fee if you work **2 shifts**. You will receive 75% for working 3 shifts. You will receive 80% for working 4 shifts. Checks will be mailed within two weeks of the sale.
2. You will work one, two, three or four, "three-hour" shift(s) before, during or after the sale. You will sign up for shift(s) on The Connecticut Kids Closet website.
3. One-shift Volunteers will be admitted to shop at the volunteer presale, 6:30-9:00pm on Friday, March . 30, 2011. Two-shift volunteers may shop at 6pm. Three shift volunteers may shop at 5:30pm. 4 shift volunteers may shop at 5pm.
4. You agree to bring items according to your scheduled appointment made on the website. The Connecticut Kids Closet reserves the rights to refuse any item that does not meet the guidelines listed on the website.
5. You are responsible for entering, pricing, tagging, and hanging your own items.
6. When entering your items, you will choose whether they are to be sold at half price ("discount") and whether they will be donated should they not sell ("donate"). Your selections are final as 11:59 PM of the Tuesday before the sale.
7. Although The Connecticut Kids Closet's employees and volunteers will do their best to ensure that items are not damaged or stolen during the drop-off, the sale, or the pick-up, we will not assume liability for consignor's items.
8. If you choose for your unsold items not to be donated, you must pick them up on the last Sunday of the sale, from 7:00pm to 9:00pm. If you do not show up during these times, your items will be donated to charity and you will be charged a \$30 disposal fee.
9. The Connecticut Kids Closet is not able to provide tax deductible receipts.
10. You agree that you will not consign or register any items that have been recalled and are on the [www.cpsc.gov](http://www.cpsc.gov) website.
- 11, Seller (Volunteer) agrees not to set up in business as a direct competitor of The Connecticut Kids Closet, LLC, within a 50 mile radius, for a period of 24 months or 2 years.
